

Corona-Related Changes to the Statute of the University of Applied Sciences Kufstein Tirol



The regulations below apply until September 2020 and replace corresponding regulations in our statutes or the respective study regulations.

- **Deviation of Examination Modalities, Course Procedures, and Examination Dates:** Course leaders are entitled to deviate from the examination modalities and didactic concepts specified in the respective study regulations, so that courses and exams can be held (e.g. virtually). If possible, the changed modalities (examination, instruction) should be communicated to the students two weeks in advance. The two-week advance notification of the examination date must be observed. This deviation affects all types of examinations (e.g. commission examinations, bachelor's and master's degree examinations, etc.). The final examination of courses should be administered before the end of the current semester, if possible.
- **Semester Dates:** Due to the discontinuation of face-to-face teaching, the entire academic program converts to eLearning methods where feasible. To ensure flexibility in this implementation, the summer semester 2020 is extended at least to the end of July; moreover, courses and exams can be offered during Easter or Pentecost periods. Of course, the best possible effort should be put forth to run the courses as planned and to support the students in this.
- **Admission Process:** In the course of the admission process, a personal presence in Kufstein can be waived and a purely virtual implementation can be made possible. In addition, the written admission process is not mandatory for all bachelor's degree programs. The following weighting is used:

- **Election of Faculty Representatives:** The members of the Council of the University of Applied Sciences and its leadership remain in their function until the next council election.
- **Virtual Participation in Council Meetings:** Participation in council meetings is also possible online. This is considered equivalent to personal participation with all the resulting rights and obligations.
- **Postponement of Courses and Semesters:** Courses from later semesters can be brought forward if administratively feasible, and courses that primarily require a presence can be postponed to subsequent semesters.
- **Admission to Bachelor Degree Examinations:** Conditional admission to the bachelor degree examination can be granted, if all courses except the integrated professional internship have been successfully completed. Only upon successful completion of the professional internship is a successful bachelor degree examination counted as completed and are degree program requirements considered fulfilled.
